Project funding

Advanced Projects

- The IZKF offers research grants in all major research areas of the Faculty of Medicine. The funding period is 30 months.
- Funding: usually one personnel position (doctoral student or technical assistant) as well as consumables
- Each project can have up to 3 applicants from the same or different department/clinic.
- Prerequisites: Active publications and own third-party funding
- Two-stage review process
- The call for proposals is every
 2-3 years; deadline in spring

Jochen-Kalden-Funding Programme

- Eligible to apply are newly appointed W1/ integrated W2/ W3 professors with tenure track or comparable at the Faculty of Medicine.
- For persons in their first 2 years of appointment from an external position
- Funding: Personnel positions and consumables are available as flexibilised funding over a period of 2 years.
- Doctorate must have been obtained within the last 8 years (10 years), parental leave is credited.
- Annual call for proposals, deadline in autumn

Junior Projects

- Eligible to apply are young postdoctoral physicians and scientists up to 35 years of age without previous significant external funding.
- Parental leave is credited.
- Funding: One personnel positions (doctoral candidates or technical assistant) as well as consumables
- Funding period: 30 months
- Physicians can additionally apply for a rotation position.
- Annual call for proposals, onestage review process; deadline in spring

Start up funding

Pilot projects

- Funding of projects, in particular for junior researchers as start-up, pilot and/or interim funding
- Also available for applicants over the age limit of 38 but with lower priority
- Funding: one personnel position as well as consumables for a period up to 12 months
- Applications can be submitted at any time. Applications are reviewed in four meetings per year.

Synergy Projects

- Funding for planned collaborative research initiatives
- Funding: Maximum 300 T€ per project for 3-6 applicants from at least 3 different departments/clinics.
- There is no age limit for synergy projects.
- The scientific independence of each individual applicant must be confirmed.
- The funding is provided for a maximum of 24 months.
- Annual call for proposals, onestage review process; deadline 15.07.

Do I(I)T

- Rotation positions for up to 3 months Ä1/ Ä2 full-time
- For preparation of IITs (focus on drawing up the protocol/ obtaining an ethics vote)
- Applications may be submitted by advanced physicians in training and specialists of all disciplines without age limit.
- Annual call for proposals twice a year

Junior Scientist Programmes

Clinician Scientist Programme

- The two-staged Clinician
 Scientist Programme is aimed
 at physicians who are in their
 specialist training, would like
 to conduct their own research
 project and would like to continue their scientific education
 within the framework of a
 structured training programme.
- Applications for admission to the CSP may be made at any time

MD Thesis Scholarships

- Up to 40 grants are available for medical students per year.
 During the full-time research activity, a scholarship is granted for a period of 8 consecutive months. In addition, participants complete specified training modules over a period of 12 months.
- Applications are reviewed in five meetings per year on the basis of the submitted application and an interview.

Laboratory Rotations

- The rotation programme is aimed at young physicians involved in clinical practice who are interested in research and who completed their doctorate. In the context of the rotation programme, they can be released from their clinical work duties either part-time or full-time in order to devote themselves to their own clearly defined research projects for a set period of time.
- The rotation can last 6 months (100%, full-time) or 12 months (50%, part-time).
- The applications are reviewed in five meetings per year.
